

Royal London introduces e-signatures

Royal London has today announced it has launched E-AMRAs to obtain customer consent for GP Reports under the Access to Medical Reports Act.

The customer will receive an encrypted email and password which once opened will allow them to electronically provide consent using DocuSign. This will then be provided to the surgery along with the GP Report request; paper options will still be available if preferred.



Royal London have advised it takes between 8 and 12 days for a paper request to be returned, during their trial last year 58% of E-AMRA consent forms were returning same day and 92% within 5 days. They hope this will improve turnaround times and reduce dropout rates.

E-AMRAs will be available on applications submitted to LifeQuote.
