

Changes to our Critical Illness Comparison Chart

Following feedback we have made some changes to our Critical Illness Comparison chart. Our aim is to provide a fair comparison across all insurer products by outlining the conditions covered, whether they are an Association of British Insurers (ABI) standard or ABI+ definition while keeping the numbers as close to the insurers own published figures.

We have also highlighted the extra benefits and services offered with each policy.

Here is a list of the changes we've made:

Full Payment Conditions

- Removed Alzheimer's as this is now combined with Dementia
- Removed Kennedy's Disease as this is now combined with Motor Neurone Disease
- Combined Open Heart Surgery and Heart Surgery
- Combined Severe Lung Disease, Respiratory Failure and Interstitial Lung Disease

Partial Payment Conditions

- Listed all less advanced cancers
- Removed Children's Critical Illness, Surgery Cover and Additional Care Benefit as these are not counted as conditions

Other Changes

- Introduced ^ to indicate when an insurer covers that condition but does not count it as a separate condition
- Changed the options listed for Support Services
- Highlighted which provider offers the service for each insurer

Don't forget you can use the "Compare" tab to look at up to 4 specific insurers, the "Vitality" tab for their Serious Illness Cover options and the "Child CI" tab to compare the specific children's cover.
